## Arrival

Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to a nearby heliport lounge and your luggage will transfer by car to the Beach Estate. You'll cover the Island of Oahu from above with a full-circle tour of about 1 and ½ hours. Up to four helicopters will carry you over Pearl Harbor, the WWII Arizona Memorial, and Battleship Missouri. Next you'll soar over Honolulu Harbor, Waikiki, and iconic Diamond Head Crater. Heading south you'll fly over Koko Head Crater and Hanauma Bay, Sandy Beach and the Makapu'u Lighthouse. Heading up the east shore, where your beach house awaits, you will come over Kailua, then Kaneohe Bay, Mokoli'i Island and Kaaawa Valley where you'll have a peek into "Jurassic Park." Then the thousand-foot cascade of Sacred Falls, accessible only by air, will come into view. And finally, you'll return to the heliport from where you'll be transferred by Sprinter to the beach house, about 30 minutes.

Beginning Sep. 1, 2020, travelers can be exempt from the quarantine by taking a valid COVID-19 test no more than 72 hours prior to their flight and providing proof of a negative test result upon arrival. The mandatory quarantine will remain in place for those who choose to not take a pre-travel test.
